1. CHARGES FOR FISHING VESSELS

TABLE 1 FISHING LOCAL COMPOSITE RATES (INCLUDING CREEL) (SUBJECT TO VAT)

By agreement with Eyemouth Harbour Trust, locally owned, registered fishing vessels using harbour facilities may, on prior application being made in writing to the Harbour Master, be allowed compounded arrangements as follows:

Notes applicable to local composite rates:

- 1. Owners/Skippers who fail to pay compounded charge within agreed terms will be liable for appropriate charge in Table 2.
- 2. The compounded charge herein shall cease to be applicable to any vessel in this class continuously occupying a berth at the Trust's quays for a period in excess of 21 days. Such vessels will then be classed as either visiting or laid up and will be liable to be charged appropriate rate in Table 2A or 2C below.
- 3. In some circumstances, landing dues may be reduced to 2.5%. Conditions apply. Please discuss with office staff.
- 4. In some circumstances, laid up dues may be applicable. Please discuss with Harbour Master.

Registered fishing vessels, which do not pay compound annual rates, but are using harbour to fish from, will be charged as follows:

TABLE 2C FISHING (LOCAL & VISITING) LAID UP DUES (SUBJECT TO VAT)

In certain circumstances, any vessel occupying a berth at the Trust's quays for a period in excess of 21 days and not landing any fish will be classed as laid up and will be liable to be charged as follows. Any vessel on laid up dues for a period exceeding 3 months will be subject to review and may result in daily rates being applied.

NOTES APPLICABLE TO ALL FISHING VESSELS whether local or visiting;

- 1. Berthing is subject to suitable arrangements being agreed in advance for collection of landing dues.
- 2. In cases where skippers sell directly to Merchants, liability to account for Landing Dues rests jointly and severally with the Skipper and Owner if the Merchant fails to account to the Trust for the Landing Dues.
- 3. All vessels must produce satisfactory evidence of Third Party Liability insurance upon application (if local) or upon entry to the harbour (if visiting). Sight of Certificate of Registration may also be required.

Notes applicable to storage of goods;

- 1. All goods and ships equipment, including trawl doors, nets, ropes, drums, lobster / crab, prawn pots and fish boxes to be stored on the quay only with the permission of, and directed by the Harbour Master.
- 2. All goods must be clearly marked with vessel's name and/or registration number.
- 3. Goods stored without permission will be charged a penalty.
- 4. Goods stored without authorisation will be disposed of after 14 days.
- 5. The Trust will not be responsible for the safe custody of any goods landed, deposited or stored upon any of their quays, wharfs, or premises; nor will they accept any liability for any loss (whether partial or total) or damage, however arising, which may happen to such goods.
- 6. As the Trust have no charge or custody of goods landed, deposited, or stored on quays, wharfs, or premises, the Trust strongly advices Owners or Consignees of such goods to arrange insurance cover to have them watched whilst the goods remain there.

FUELS AND PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

Vessels who do not have an account with Chrystal Petroleum, who require fuel from the tank should contact the Harbour Master.

Fuel agents are permitted to sell fuel across the quayside, however, in these circumstances, the following regulations will apply;

- 1. Any company, agency or individual wishing to use Eyemouth Harbour Trust quays for the transfer of petroleum products to and from vessels must first apply and obtain written permission from the Trust. Any company, agency or individual not obtaining written permission will not be allowed to undertake any transfer of petroleum products.
- 2. All approved agencies supplying Fuel and other Oils <u>must account monthly</u> to Eyemouth Harbour Trust for the total amount of oils, which have been exported or sold across the quay.
- 3. Failure to comply with the above will result in the consent being withdrawn.
