LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 5 of 2019

Workboat operations in the entrance area.

Date of Issue: 20th February 2019

1. MARINERS ARE HEREBY ADVISED that workboat operations will take place in Eyemouth Harbour Entrance over several days beginning on Wednesday 20th February 2019.
2. The 14m x 6m workboat, 'Forth Umpire' will conduct operations in the entrance area and 'the canyon' to replace AtN and safety ladders.
3. The Forth Umpire and the Harbour will monitor and use VHF Ch.12 as a working frequency during this operation.
4. The vessel may be grounded over low tides to conduct these operations.
5. Mariners are advised that temporary restriction to vessel movements may occur and they should navigate with caution in the vicinity. In particular, if intending to pass the workboat they should ensure that the boat's crew are aware and have ceased operating to allow passage, before committing to enter or depart.
6. A berth at Gunsgreen Basin will be reserved for the workboat as necessary.
