

EYEMOUTH HARBOUR LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 4 of 2020

Harbour Dredging Operations

Date of Issue: 17th July 2020

1. MARINERS ARE HEREBY ADVISED that dredging operations will take place in Eyemouth Harbour beginning on or around 18th July 2020.
2. Shearwater dredging will be conducting operations in the entrance, canyon, Gunsreen basin and inner harbour.

All vessels must contact Harbour Master when entering or leaving the harbour, using VHF Ch 12.

3. Mariners are advised that temporary restriction to vessel movements may occur and should navigate with caution. If intending to pass Shearwater when engaged in dredging operations, seek permission to do so from the dredger. Shearwater can cease operations to ensure safe passage, before committing to enter or depart.

Harbour Master will issue a Security message before dredging ops commence.

4. Fairways are to be kept clear for navigation i.e. North Channel, East Channel and approaches to entrance. Ropes must not be laid or allowed to float across the track of vessels entering or leaving the harbour.
5. A berth at Gunsreen Basin will be reserved for the dredger.

Fishing vessel's cooperation will be greatly appreciated.

During this time vessels may be required to move berth as directed by the Harbour Master, to facilitate dredging operations.
