LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No.3 of 2021 – updated & revised 29/03/21

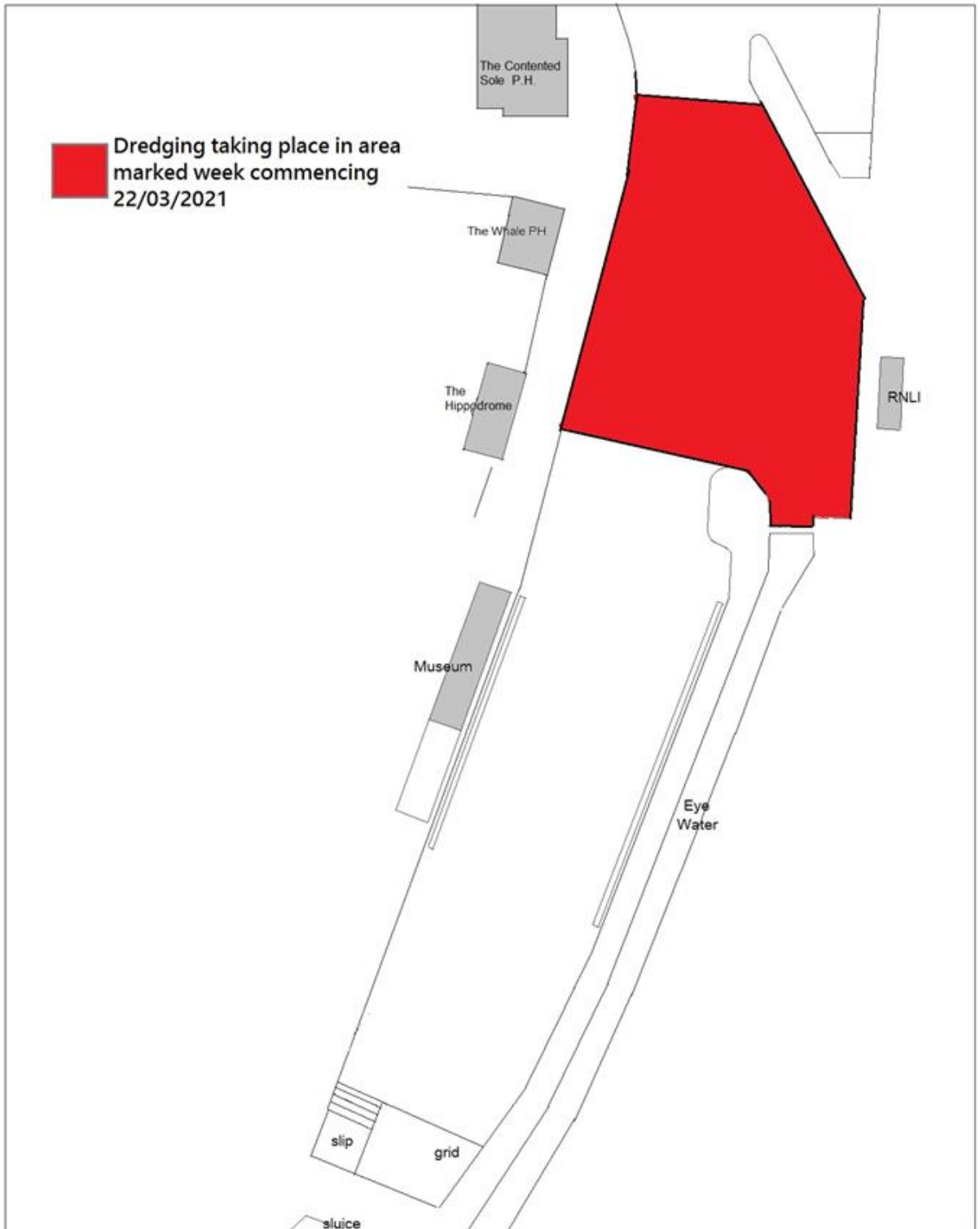

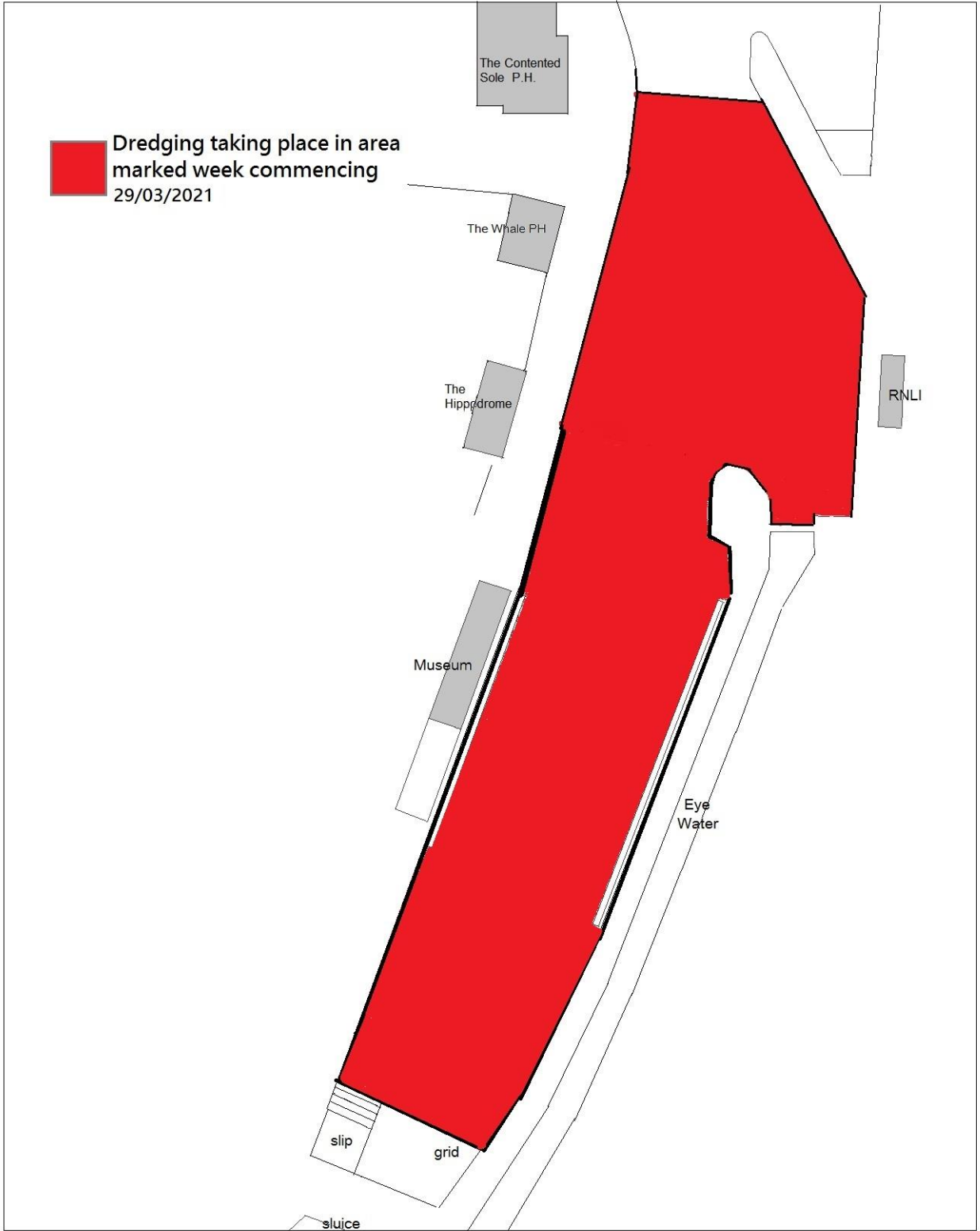
1. MARINERS ARE HEREBY ADVISED that dredging operations will take place in Eyemouth Harbour beginning on or around the 24th March 2021.
2. MV Shearwater will commence dredging by the lifeboat station and the pub Contented Sole as indicated on the plan below:
3. All vessels must contact Harbour Master when entering or leaving the harbour, using VHF Ch.12
4. Mariners are advised that temporary restrictions to vessel movements may occur and that they should navigate with caution. If intending to pass Shearwater when engaged in dredging operations, seek permission to do so from Shearwater on VHF Ch.12.
Shearwater can cease operations to ensure safe passage.
5. A berth at Gunsgreen basin will be reserved for the dredger.
6. During this time vessels may be required to move berth as directed by the Harbour Master, to facilitate dredging operations.
Vessel's cooperation will be greatly appreciated.
