**FISHING LOCAL COMPOSITE VESSELS**

**ALL LANDING DUES ARE BEING REDUCED TO 2.5%  
FROM JUNE 2010 FOR 6 MONTH TRIAL PERIOD**

**FISHING VISITING RATES (SUBJECT TO VAT)  
COMPOUNDED RATES**

Registered visiting fishing vessels, which qualify for compounded rates for this trial period, and are landing in Eyemouth on a regular basis, charges detailed below:

	6 Months Berthing	Landings
Up to 10 m LOA	£170.00	2.5%
Per Additional Metre	£17.00	2.5%

**NON COMPOUNDED RATES**

Registered fishing vessels, which do not pay compounded rates, but are using harbour to fish from on an occasional basis, will be charged as follows:

	Daily Berthing	Landings
Up to 10 m LOA	£15.00 per day	2.5%
Per Additional Metre	£1.50 per day	2.5%

**NOTES APPLICABLE TO ALL FISHING VESSELS whether local or visiting;**

1. Benefit of reduced landing dues is subject to completion of declaration for permission to obtain landings data from Marine Scotland.
2. In cases where skippers sell directly to Merchants, liability to account for Landing Dues rests jointly and severally with the Skipper and Owner if the Merchant fails to account to the Trust for the Landing Dues.
3. All vessels must produce satisfactory evidence of Third Party Liability insurance upon application (if local) or upon entry to the harbour (if visiting). Sight of Certificate of Registration may also be required.
4. The compounded charge herein shall cease to be applicable to any vessel in this class continuously occupying a berth at the Trust's quays for a period in excess of 28 days. Any such vessels may then be classed as laid up and will be liable to be charged accordingly.
5. All compounded dues must be paid in advance of the period to which they apply.
6. The compounded charges will remain available to vessels, which continue to land in Eyemouth on a regular basis. If landings fall below minimum level of average landings, the right to compounded dues may be lost for the following season.
7. Spot checks on landings will be carried out randomly.
8. Normal terms and conditions of entry to the harbour apply.
