

EYEMOUTH HARBOUR LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 7 of 2016

Static Gear

Date of Issue: 21 September 2016

- 1. Creel fishermen are reminded to observe good practice in using static gear in the vicinity of Eyemouth Harbour.
- 2. All gear must be marked with buoys that are large enough to be seen (not plastic bottles, etc.) and buoys are to be painted with boat name or registration.
- 3. Fairways are to be kept clear for navigation i.e. North Channel, East Channel and approaches to entrance. Ropes must not be laid or allowed to float across the track of vessels entering or leaving the harbour.
- 4. Any gear reported or found to be obstructing navigation may be lifted and removed on the order of the Harbour Master and costs charged to the owner.
