

EYEMOUTH HARBOUR

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

No. 3 of 2021 - Updated and revised on 28/05/2021

Date of issue: 23rd of March 2021 - updated and revised on 28th of May 2021.

- 1. MARINERS ARE HEREBY ADVISED that dredging operations will take place in Eyemouth Harbour beginning around the 29th 30th of May 2021.
- 2. MV Shearwater will commence dredging in Gunsgreen Basin and the harbour entrance (canyon) along with several loads to be completed the inner harbour.
- 3. All vessels must contact the Harbour Master when entering or leaving the harbour using VHF CH.12
- 4. Mariners are advised that temporary restrictions to vessel and movements may occur and that they should navigate with caution. If intending to pass MV Shearwater when engaged in dredging operations, seek permission to do so by contacting Shearwater on VHF CH.12 Shearwater can cease operations to ensure safe passage.
- 5. A berth at Gunsgreen Basin will be reserved for the dredger.
- During the time vessels may be required to move berth as directed by the Harbour Master, to facilitate dredging operations.
 Vessel's cooperation will be greatly appreciated.
