

Notification of Pontoon Installation and Electrical preparation works at Gungreen Quay.

w/c 29th Nov 2021 for approx. 3 weeks.

Pontoon Installation

As part of the Neart na Gaoithe Operations & Maintenance facility at Eyemouth Harbour, installation will start on the two new pontoons in Gungreen Basin w/c 29th Nov 2021.

The works will involve large plant and equipment arriving on Gungreen Quay on 29th November with pontoon sections being lifted into the basin on 30th November and 1st December.

In preparation for these works, EHT will be fencing off the area and access will be restricted in the immediate vicinity of the Harbour building and quayside area. Access for fishing fleet and emergency vehicles will be maintained. Installation works are expected until 21st December 2021 and access to the areas shown, and some parking restrictions will be in force throughout this time.

- Additional car parking is available in the SBC long stay car park at Gungreenhill, at the top of the steps.
- Area for net repair will remain along Gungreen Quay.
- Road access along to the turning circle will remain clear.

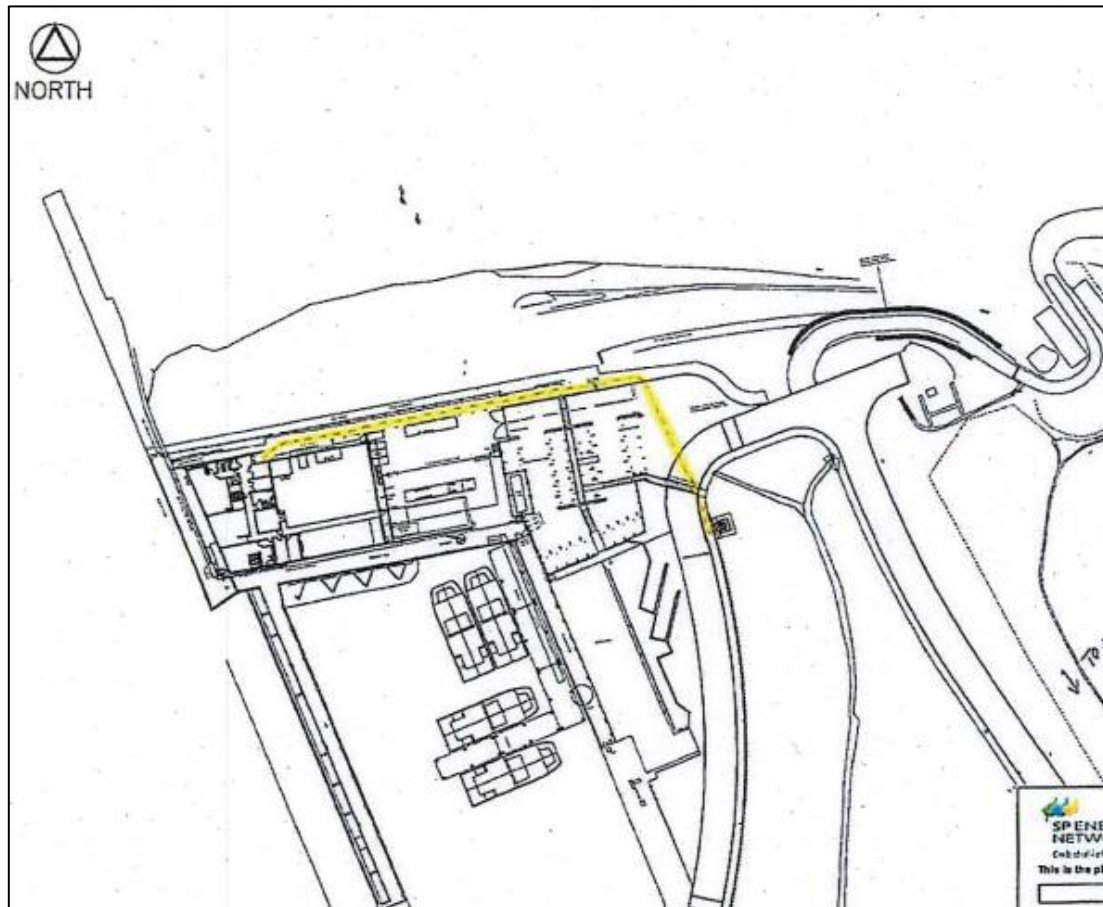
